## Summer Disco

On Monday 18<sup>th</sup> June there will be discos held for the children of St Joseph's. For health and safety reasons these discos are only open to pupils at the school.

Parents are not required to stay as children will be supervised by members of staff and the Friends of St Joseph's. There is not sufficient room in the hall to accommodate parents who wish to stay at the disco. After the disco is finished, children will be released on the KS1 school yard. Parents and carers are asked to stand on the school yard to collect their child.
