Parking Problems in the streets around the school

We have had complaints from local residents who are experiencing difficulty when trying to drive in and out of their street and who are unable to access their garages as they are blocked by some cars parked inconsiderately. This has happened to different residents on different occasions both in the mornings and in the afternoons and those residents have complained to school.

These residents are within their rights to report the incidents to the police.

Please be aware of residents' right of entry when parking and also consider the inconvenience of being unable to access your garage or your drive.

Parking in the gym car park and walking through the school car park

There is still a major issue concerning parents parking in the gym car park. I have been asked by the gym to reiterate that those spaces are private parking places for members of the gym only.

We, as a school, put our children's safety above all else and are very concerned that parents are taking their children through the school car park.

For safety reasons, all children, with the exception of those who have prior permission from me, are not allowed in the school car park between the following times:

8:40 am and 9:10 am

3:00 pm and 3:25 pm

Parents must bring their children into school via the upper gate at the top of the KS1 yard.

Please do not allow your child to walk through the school car park without an adult at any time.



I would appreciate if parents and carers could relay these concerns to grandparents and other relatives or friends who may collect children from school.

I'd like to apologise to the vast majority of parents and carers to whom this letter does not apply and to thank them for showing consideration by parking away from the school and walking a short distance. Your consideration is greatly appreciated.
